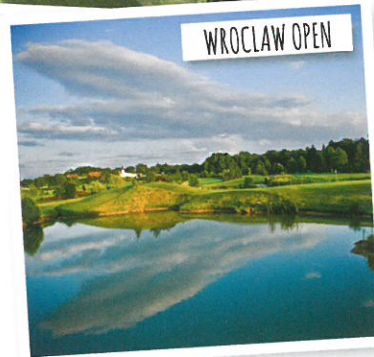
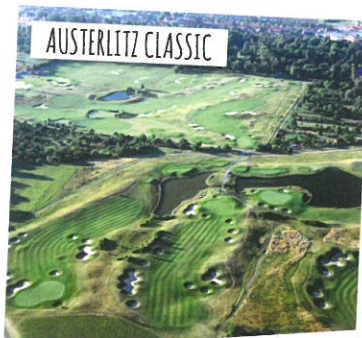


Newcomers, playoffs, great sport and passion

There are 21 tournaments in six different countries on the Pro Golf Tour calendar in the 2017 season. Prize money of 650,000 euro is being distributed and just as many points for the Pro Golf Tour Order of Merit, the official tour ranking, are being issued in the process.

An early start to the tour on excellent courses in the sunny South, return to Central Europe to tried and tested venues at the end of April and top-class newcomers: the Pro Golf Tour 2017 season promises plenty of sporting highlights.

The tournament year starts with two events by the Red Sea in Egypt, followed by six tournaments in Morocco. The tour has been fostering a close partnership with the Association du Trophée Hassan II de Golf since 2010. Austria is represented on the tournament calendar four times this year, in Zell am See for the first time too. The players travel twice to both the Czech Republic and Poland, and five competitions are scheduled in Germany. The newcomer here is the Starnberg Open, which marks the home game for the Pro Golf Tour based in Munich from 16 to 18 August. All the 2017 tournaments with the season final in Adendorf and the Q-School in Paderborn GC are shown on the second last page of this brochure.

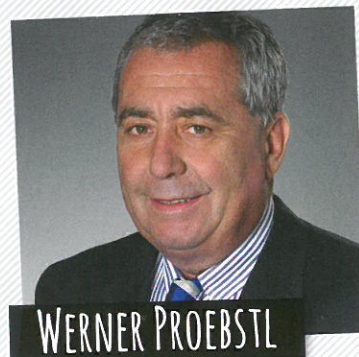
